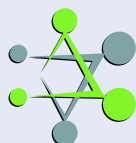

PREAMBLE

Chemicals and petrochemical sectors have been growing at a fast pace during the last decade. In spite of this, the average per capita consumption of polymer in India is much below the world average. Keeping the above in view and to have a faster growth, Govt. of India had embarked on conceptualisation of Petroleum, Chemicals and Petrochemical Investment Region (PCPIR) in a meeting with industries on 12th December 2005.

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), Govt. of India in its meeting held on 8th March 2007 approved the Policy Resolution for setting up of PCPIRs in different parts of the country. The Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals, Govt. of India and respective state governments have actively showcased and promoted the PCPIRs through various investor meets, exhibitions and national and international road shows. In its meeting of 23rd February 2009 the CCEA approved proposals of the respective governments for PCPIRs in Vishakhapatnam (AP), Dahej (Gujrat), Haldia (West Bengal), Paradeep (Odisha) and Mangalore (Karnataka) which are expected to attract industrial investment to the tune of ₹ 4,86,180 crore.

The PCPIR at Paradeep, proposed by Government of Odisha and approved by CCEA, covers an area of 284.15 sq km with a processing area of 123.014 sq km in Jagatsinghpur and Kendrapara districts. The Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL), which is setting up a 15 MTPA oil refinery at Paradeep, has been identified as the Anchor Tenant for the Odisha PCPIR. The PCPIR hub at Paradeep is expected to attract investment to the tune of ₹ 2.74 lakh crore. But the implementation of PCPIR programme in the state is on the slow lane.

Paradeep is in the process of becoming a large industrial hub in Odisha. Paradeep port is a major port in the eastern coast of India. Two major fertilizer plants i. e. Paradeep Phosphates Ltd. (PPL) and Indian Farmers Fertilizer Co-operative Limited (IFFCO) are presently operating at Paradeep and many large industries such as ESSAR Steel, POSCO and others are in the pipeline. The 15 MTPA petroleum refinery of IOCL is scheduled to start its production in 2014.

On the above background, Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (IICChE), Bhubaneswar Regional Centre in association with Indian Chemical Council, Mumbai is organizing a one-day seminar on "Petroleum, Chemicals and Petrochemical Investment Region at Paradeep (PCPIR-Paradeep)" at Bhubaneswar on 10th March 2014. The above seminar aims at bringing together the Anchor Client, Developers, Experts from Industries, Investors, Research Institutes, Academia and Policy Planning Bodies on one platform to put forth their views through **Invited Lectures** in order to accelerate the process of PCPIR at Paradeep.

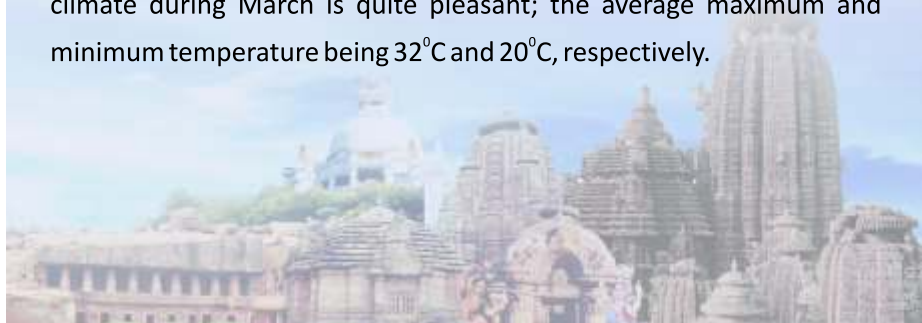
